

In 2007, Prosperitas Capital Partners signed a technical cooperation agreement with the MIF, the National Development Corporation, and the Technological Laboratory of Uruguay to finance a comprehensive program, known as Programa Emprender, to support dynamic business development in Uruguay. 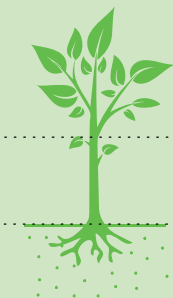

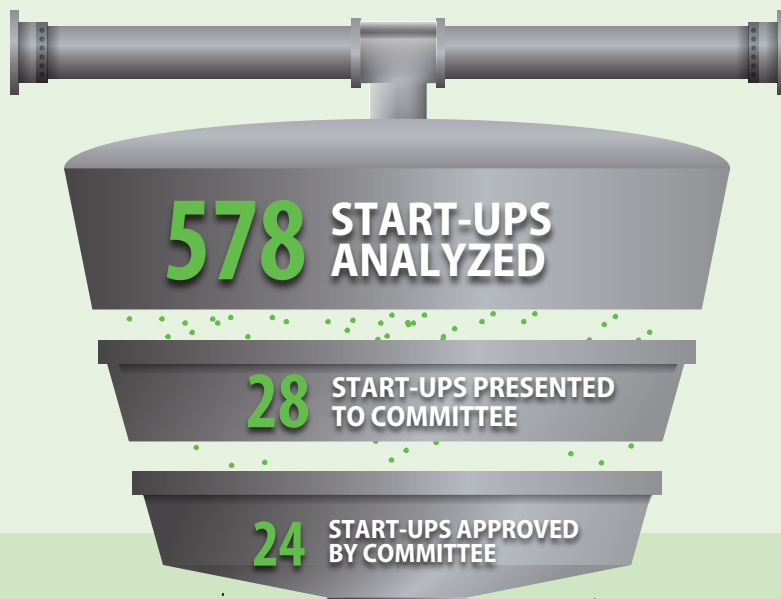
#### STAGE OF MATURITY AT WHICH IT WAS FINANCED

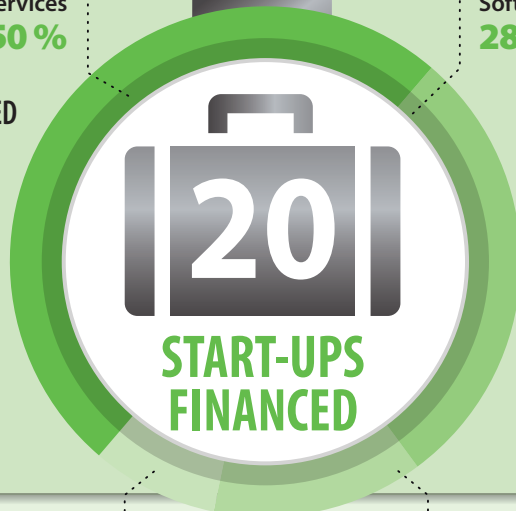
