


Key Results

Include a descriptive introduction and key results. List the project's results in terms of access to and use of the services or products provided by the project, using indicators included in the logframe. (for example: number of new microcredit clients, number of people trained, number of people with drinking water in their home, etc.).

- ▶ Key results of the project.
- ▶ If the project is ongoing, identify relevant results achieved to date compared with the expected results.
- ▶ If the project is completed, indicate the results achieved.
- ▶ The use of illustrations and graphics is recommended.

Lessons Learned

- ▶ In one sentence, identify the essence of the lesson learned.
- ▶ Lessons learned can be defined as knowledge gained about a process or one or more experiences through reflection and critical analysis. The results of this experiment or process can be positive or negative.



Project Impact

List the impacts achieved by the project in terms of socio-economic benefits, quality of life, and/or environmental improvements for the project beneficiaries, using indicators included in the logframe. For example:

- ▶ changes in income,
- ▶ consumption,
- ▶ employment,
- ▶ sales,
- ▶ profitability,
- ▶ export companies created,
- ▶ women's empowerment,
- ▶ health,
- ▶ nutrition,
- ▶ education, etc.

Next Steps (if the project is ongoing) / Additional Activities (if the project is completed)

- ▶ Next steps: If the project is ongoing, describe the next actions planned.
- ▶ Additional activities: If the project is completed, explain if it has been replicated or scaled, or if additional activities were carried out as a result of the project.
